



## Lillian Hautala

Lillian E. Hautala, 98, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Sunday, January 20, 2013 at the Iron County Medical Care Facility.

She was born on October 12, 1914 in Stambaugh, daughter of the late Isaac and Maria (Sillenpaa) Koivu. Lillian graduated from Crystal Falls High School in 1933 and was a lifelong resident of the area. She married Arvo Hautala on December 8, 1935 in Amasa. He preceded her in death on May 20, 1987. Lillian was employed as a cook at the Iron County Medical Care Facility for 24 years. She also worked at the Senior Citizens Center in Amasa for many years. Lillian was an active member of Bethany Lutheran Church in Amasa for over 70 years where she served on the church council and was a Sunday School teacher. She was also very involved as a 4-H leader for over 30 years. Lillian enjoyed knitting and made lots of clothing for her family and rag rugs on her loom. She also enjoyed gardening, planting flowers and splitting wood.
