Agnes E. Lehto, 101, of Crystal Falls, MI, passed away Wednesday, January 31, 2024, at the Iron County Medical Care Facility.

She was born on December 24, 1922, in Crystal Falls, MI, daughter of the late John and Helmi (Isaacson) Wierikko. A 1941 graduate of Forest Park High School in Crystal Falls, MI, she married Towner E. Lehto in Waukegan, IL, on December 23, 1944, and they moved to Swan Lake, MI, in 1949.
