Allan Paul Stacy, 77, of Crystal Falls, passed away peacefully on Friday, June 2 2017, at Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center, Iron Mountain.

He was born May 20, 1940, in Crystal Falls, son of the late Clarence and Mildred (Payne) Stacy.

Allan attended the Crystal Falls Schools. He was an outstanding fullback and was chosen for All-State as well as the All-UP First Team in 1958. Following graduation in 1959, he enlisted and served in the U. S. Army and was honorably discharged in 1962.

From 1963-1969, Allan worked in Mequon, WI, for a landscaper and in the Milwaukee area as an apprentice-plumber. Upon returning to Crystal Falls in 1969, he carried on a third generation family tradition by “working on the railroad.” He joined the crew of the Chicago Northwestern Railroad (later became Union Pacific) as a fireman. Later he became an engineer and retired in 1997.

Allan was a Green Bay Packer fan, although he held a general interest in other sports. He enjoyed hunting, and especially looked forward to spending

time at camp.

Allan is survived by his children, Paul (Janice) Stacy, Crystal Falls and Kathie (Jeff) Clark, Willseyville, California; one sister, Joyce (Bob) Jackson, Merrill, WI; one brother, Bill (Doris) Stacy, Crystal Falls; two grandchildren, Kristin and Brad Stacy; several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and cousins. In addition to his parents, Allan was preceded in death by an infant daughter, Mary; sisters, Marjorie Gustafson and Ruth Makuck.
