Bruce (Coal Shoot) Kangas

65, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Friday, July 26th at the Oscar J. Johnson VA Medical Center in Iron Mountain.

Bruce was born on November 6, 1953 at Baraga County Memorial Hospital. He was the son of the late Jalmer and Joyce (Abramson) Kangas. Bruce moved with his family to Crystal Falls in 1957 and attended Crystal Falls Schools. He joined the United States Army in 1971 and served until his honorable discharge as a specialist E-4. After his discharge from the Army, Bruce went back to school and earned his high school diploma through West Iron County Adult Education.
