



Calvin "Bob" Henry Heimerl

February 4, 1928 - April 14, 2022

Calvin "Bob" Heimerl, 94, of Amasa, MI passed away Thursday, April 14, 2022, at Aspirus Iron River Hospital with his family by his side.

He was born February 4, 1928, in Breed, WI, the son of Fred and Emma (Zeireis) Heimerl.

Bob moved to Amasa in 1947, he worked as a jobber for various loggers. He entered the Army in 1950 and served in the Old Guard, 3rd Infantry in Fort Meyers, VA. In 1952 he married Audrey in Washington, DC. They returned to Amasa later that year. In 1956, Bob formed a partnership, Heimerl Bros, with his brother Morris. He retired in 1993.

Bob was an active member of the Amasa community including 37 years with the Amasa Volunteer Fire Department.

He is survived by his wife, Audrey (Pagel); daughters, Debbie Holden and Barb Laughbaum; sons, Lee and Paul; 5 grandchildren; as well as his sister, Amy Anderson.

He was preceded in death by his brothers, Chauncey, Gale, Tugg, Sheridan and Morris; also his sisters, Patricia, Hazel and Margie.
