Charles Edward Nelson, 79, of Crystal Falls, MI, passed away on November 17, 2020, at home surrounded by his family.

Charles was born in Crystal Falls to Eino and Mary (Karnack) Nelson on July 4, 1941. He married Virginia Kangas on July 29, 1961, in Amasa, MI. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1961 to 1965 as an aircraft hydraulics specialist, working on the C-130s. He worked for the Great Lakes Gas Transmission Company in Crystal Falls for 29 years, retiring in 2000. He was a member of United Lutheran Church of Crystal Falls and was involved in the Sno-Kats Snowmobile Club, and the American Legion. Charles had his Country & Western band, The Chuck Nelson Trio, entertaining local crowds, weddings, and festivals for many years.

Charles is survived by his wife of almost 60 years, Virginia; his children, Warren (Lisa) Nelson and Wendy Nelson; 4 grandchildren, Matthew and Kaisa Nelson and Lauren and Steven Cooper; 1 great-granddaughter, Lena Nelson; and 2 brothers, Jules and Leslie Nelson.

Charles is preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Catherine Gill.
