Cheryle Lynn Spicer, 69, of Crystal Falls, MI, passed away Tuesday, January 30, 2024, at Aspirus Hospital in Wausau, WI, with her husband and sons by her side.

Cheryle was born August 21, 1954, in Milwaukee, WI, daughter of the late Jack and June (Clements) Stachowicz. She graduated from Custer High School in Milwaukee with the Class of 1972. Cheryle married Curt Spicer on October 10, 1981, in Minneapolis, MN. She was involved with The Salvation Army for many years in Minnesota, Wisconsin and Iron Mountain, MI. Most recently, Cheryle has been the co-pastor, along with her husband Curt, at Faith Fellowship Bible Church in Crystal Falls since its inception in 2005.
