Chester P. Novey, 91, of Alpha, passed away on Thursday, March 17, 2016 at the Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls.

He was born April 29, 1924 in Crystal Falls, MI, son of the late Stanley and Sophie (Osika) Nawoj. Chester graduated from Alpha High School in 1942 and enlisted in the United States Marine Corp where he served his country for 4 years. He married Maxine Weackler on January 17, 1948 in West Allis, WI. She preceded him in death on February 12, 1992. Chester worked as a machinist for Allis-Chalmers in Milwaukee, WI, for 37 years, retiring in 1983 and moving back to Alpha. He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing.
