Chris C. Nelson, 83, of Crystal Falls, passed away Thursday, December 12th, 2024, at Aspirus Iron River Hospital.

Chris was born May 8, 1941 in Milwaukee, WI, son of the late Oscar Clarence "O.C." and Gwendolyn (Kufahl) Nelson.
