CRYSTAL FALLS - Clifford "Cliff" D. Hall, 70, of Crystal Falls, died on Saturday, May 2, 2009, at his home.

He was born on Feb. 9, 1939 in Dyer, Ind., son of the late Adolphus and Lucille (Sours) Hall.
