



## Conrad "Connie" Olson

Conrad G. "Connie" Olson, 82, of Amasa, passed away on Friday, Sept. 10, 2010, at Marquette General Hospital.

He was born on April 21, 1928, in Iron River, son of the late Gilbert and Emelia (Thunander) Olson. He attended the Bates School, and then entered the United States Navy in 1946 and was honorably discharged.

Conrad married Wilma Koski of Amasa in 1949 at the First Lutheran Church in Iron River.

He was a member of the Operating Engineers Local 324 as a heavy equipment operator in the construction industry until his retirement. Since that time he enjoyed hunting, fishing, trapping, and spending time at camp at Paint River.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Wilma of Amasa; three sons, Terry Olson of Amasa, Tom (Kathy) Olson of Crandon, Wis., and Mick Olson of Amasa; a sister, Patricia (Robert) Pozniak of Iron River; five grandchildren, and 14 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a daughter, Nancy, and his grandson, Terry.
