80 of Crystal Falls, passed away on Thursday, April 19, 2018 at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center in Iron Mountain. He was born on September 20, 1937 in Chicago, son of the late Leo S. and Fanny (Grad) Bernards. He graduated from Senn High School in Chicago. After graduating he enlisted in the United States Army Finance Corps. serving most of his time in Vicenza, Italy. He was Honorably discharged in 1963.

David worked as a lighting salesman for Delta Sales in Chicago for several years. He then met and married Kathryn Alexa on April 16, 1977, and together they just celebrated 41 wonderful years together. He left his salesman job to drive a Yellow Cab in Chicago for 30 years, before retiring in 2002. He loved meeting and talking to new people. He knew the city like the back of his hand, and at one time or another chauffeured most of Chicago's TV, radio and political celebrities. But he also counted other celebrities among his customers including Steve Martin and Muhammad Ali.
