Delvina Stolberg, 99, of Stambaugh, passed away on Sunday, November 5, 2017 at Aspirus Hospital in Iron River. She was born on October 16, 1918 in Stambaugh, daughter of the late George and Mary (Baker) O'Donnell. She grew up in and attended the Stambaugh schools.

Delvina was a lifelong resident of Stambaugh. She married Lambert Stolberg on April 14, 1936 and he preceded her in death on May 21, 2002. She and her husband owned and operated Stolberg's Lawn Ornaments. She was a lifelong member of St. Cecilia Catholic Church in Caspian. She enjoyed playing cards, the magic of Halloween and going to the casino. Christmas Eve was a tradition at the family home.
