



Dennis "Ladder" Fabbri

August 14, 1950 - April 11, 2016

Dennis "Ladder" Fabbri 65, of Crystal Falls, passed away on April 11th at his home with his family and friends at his side.

Dennis was born August 14th 1950 , son of the late Bay and Rose (Dal Lago) Fabbri. He was a lifelong resident of Crystal Falls and graduated from Crystal Falls High School in 1968. He earned a Bachelors of Science Degree from Northern Michigan University. He was married to Cindy "Sophie" Simbob April 16th 1977 at Guardian Angels Parish in Crystal Falls.

Dennis worked for the City of Crystal Falls Public Works department before retiring as the Public Works foreman in June of 2006. He was a volunteer firefighter with the Crystal Falls Fire Department for 21 years. Dennis was a Michigan High School Athletic Association football and volleyball referee for many years. He loved spending time fishing and especially bird hunting with his dogs.
