



## Dorothy M. Premo

December 24, 1924 - February 19, 2025

Dorothy "Dorie" Premo, age 100, passed away on February 19, 2025, at the Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls.

She was born December 24, 1924, in Ontonagon, MI, the daughter of the late Tim and Sue (Moran) Nipert. Dorie was a 1943 graduate of Ontonagon High School.
