Eileen Elaine Stebic, 89, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Tuesday, March 18, 2025.

Eileen was born December 26, 1935, in Crystal Falls, daughter of the late Walfred and Helmi (Hendrickson) Macki. She graduated from Crystal Falls High School in 1954 and was a lifelong resident of the area. Eileen married John J. Stebic on October 8, 1955, at Bethany Lutheran Church in Amasa; he preceded her in death on March 1, 1991. Eileen worked at the Iron County Court House starting in the Equalization Department, then as Deputy Register of Deeds, and later as Register of Deeds, retiring after serving 36 years. She loved dancing, animals, and enjoyed watching the wildlife in her yard. Eileen traveled extensively over the years and was an excellent cook. Most of all, she also enjoyed entertaining and having family and friends over to her house.

She is survived by a son, Curtis (Michelle) Stebic and a daughter, Lori (Kevin) Gale, both of Crystal Falls; four grandchildren, Arron and Daniel Stebic, Angela (Tim) Laranio, and Nathan (Ty) Maycroft; three great-grandchildren, Timothy Laranio, Ezio and Serenity Maycroft; and numerous nieces and nephews.
