



## Elmer "Marv" Marvin

September 6, 1925 - July 20, 2014

Elmer "Marv" Marvin, 88, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Sunday, July 20, 2014, at the Iron County Medical Care Facility.

He was born Sept. 6, 1925, in Detroit, the son of the late Elmer and Zola Marvin. He attended the Detroit area schools and graduated. Marv married Carmelita Mann and she preceded him in death on May 12, 1978. He married Lois (Cutshaw) Parker on Aug. 17, 1978.
