Frank was born on November 5, 1939 in Caspian, MI, son of the late Jacob and Katherine (Ball) Stachowicz. He grew up in Alpha and attended school there before joining the United States Army in 1958. He served during the Korean War and the Berlin Crisis and was honorably discharged in 1964. After his service he spent ten years in South Milwaukee and owned and operated an auto body shop in Cudahy, WI. He returned to Crystal Falls in 1978 and operated Frank's Auto Body in Crystal Falls until his retirement in 2000.

Frank was a talented auto body repairman and mechanic. He loved working on cars and just about anything else with a motor that needed repair. Frank's passion for this continues today through his sons. He loved spending time with his family and especially enjoyed boating on Way Dam with them. Frank also enjoyed dancing, especially polka's and square dances.
