Gloria Chervo, 86 of Crystal Falls, passed away on Wednesday, October 28, 2015 at the Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls. She was born on April 16, 1929 in Crystal Falls, Michigan, daughter of the late Emilio and Madalena (Carlotto) Chervo.

She attended school in Crystal Falls graduating from Crystal Falls High School in 1947. She attended Cleary Business College in Ypsilanti and was an honor student at Eastern Michigan University, graduating in February of 1960. She began her graduate studies at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor and completed her Master's Degree at Northern Michigan University. She was hired in September as an instructor in Physical Education. In 1962 she advanced to Assistant Professor in the department of health, Physical Ed and Recreation.
