Gloria Jane Harrison, age 96, of Crystal Falls, Michigan died on Saturday, November 1, 2014.

Gloria was born December 6, 1917 in Crystal Falls, daughter of the late Walter Sr., and Hattie Wiggins. She was a lifelong resident of Crystal Falls, graduating from Crystal Falls High School in 1936. She was selected to play a French Horn solo at her High School Senior banquet. She married Dr. Thomas R. Harrison on September 17, 1949 at St. Marks Episcopal Church and they celebrated their 51st anniversary in September of 2000. He preceded her in death on September 29, 2000. Gloria was employed as executive secretary in the Office of Price Administration for Iron County during World War II. She then worked at the First National Bank of Crystal Falls and later in the office of Dr. R. B. Hockings and Dr. T. R. Harrison. She enjoyed gardening, flower growing, cooking and baking especially for her family, camping and going to the hunting camp with family and friends. She also enjoyed having all her family at her cottage on Fortune Lake. Gloria is survived by one daughter, Sally (Tom) Peterson of Traverse City, Michigan and four sons: Dr. James (Marilee) of Crystal Falls, Michigan, Richard (Cecelia) of Escanaba, Attorney John of Crystal Falls and Robert (Janet) of St. Paul, Minnesota.
