STAMBAUGH - Gwendolyn Lorraine Andler, 92, of Stambaugh died Wednesday, November 18, 2009, at the Iron River Care Center, surrounded by the ones who loved her, and where she worked as a Nurse's Aide for 25 years, retiring at the age of 62.
