March 19, 1921 - August 3, 2018

Harding "Ole" Olsen,

97, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Thursday, August 2, , 2018 at Iron County Medical Care Facility. Harding was born on March 19, 1921 in Crystal Falls, son of the late Harold and Lettie (Haines) Olsen. He has been a lifelong resident and was a 1939 graduate of Crystal Falls High School. Harding joined the United States Army in 1942 and served during WWII in Normandy, Northern France and Rhineland. He was awarded the Purple Heart, Combat Infantryman Badge, Expert Infantryman Badge, ETO Service Ribbon and three Bronze Service Stars. Harding was honorably discharged in 1945. He worked for thirteen years as a turnkey for the Iron County Sheriff's Department and went on to work for many years in the Iron County Equalization Department. After retirement, Harding Volunteered for thirteen years at the Iron Mountain VA Medical Center. He was a member of Grace Presbyterian Church in Sagola, the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) and the Disabled American Veterans (DAV).

Harding was active in the community and enjoyed golfing at the Crystal View Golf Club and bowling with the local bowling league. He loved the outdoors, especially bowhunting. He was also a member of the Michigan Bowhunters Assoc. and was inducted into the Michigan Bowhunters Hall of Fame in 1989.

Harding is survived by his wife, Mae and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Harold and Gary Olsen.

Visitation will be from 10:00-11:00am on Wednesday, August 8th at the Nash Funeral Home of Crystal Falls.

Funeral services will be follow at 11:00am Wednesday at the funeral home. Rev. Ryan Flunker will officiate.

Burial will be in Evergreen Memorial Cemetery in Crystal Falls.
