Harold N. Gill, 93, of Amasa, MI passed away Sunday, November 3, 2019.

Harold was born in Amasa, MI on August 8, 1926 to Harry and Lillian (Pari) Gill. He was a 1944 graduate of Amasa High School. He enlisted in the US Navy on August 24, 1944 and served until June 8, 1946. Harold was a World War II Veteran and served in the European and Pacific Theaters. On July 7, 1948 he married Catherine Nelson at Emanuel Lutheran Church. Together they made their home in Amasa and raised five children. Harold worked at the Warner Mine in Amasa for many years before moving into law enforcement. After serving as Under Sheriff, he was elected as the Iron County Sheriff in 1974 and served until 1988. Throughout his life he enjoyed hunting, working on cars and was a die hard Detroit Tiger and Detroit Lion fan.

Harold is survived by his children, Candy Soderena of Amasa, Jim (Kathleen) Gill of Amasa, Joe Gill of Gaastra, Michael (Lisa Powel) Gill of Iron River and Tammy (Al) Jaeger of Crystal Falls; 12 grandchildren; and 23 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife Catherine, 2 sisters and 3 brothers.

Visitation will take place on Saturday, November 16, 2019 at Bethany Lutheran Church in Amasa from 10:00 am until 12 noon. A memorial service

will follow at 12 noon at the church with Pastor Vicky Prewitt officiating.

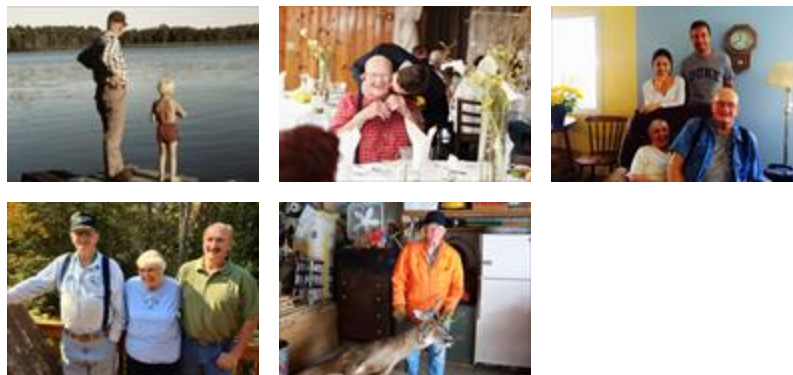

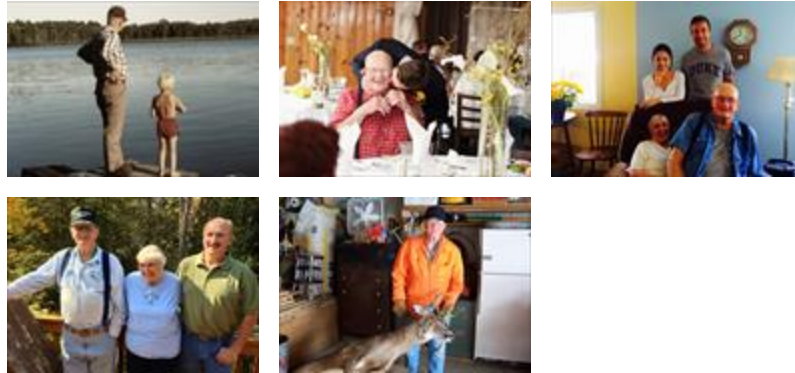
