Harvey E. Plant, 83, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2011 at his home.

Harvey was born on Jan. 21, 1928, in Flint, Mich, son of the late Ernest and Clara (Hallman) Plant. He was raised in Saginaw, Mich. and was a Saginaw High School graduate. Harvey was a veteran of the Korean War, serving in the United States Army. He resided in Saginaw, where he was a design engineer for the Baker Perkins Co. for 38 years, until his retirement in 1985.

On Sept. 29, 1989, Harvey married Sue Ann Frost. They lived in Tawas, Mich. for 15 years before moving to the Crystal Falls area in 2003.
