



## Jack Richard Koivisto

September 8, 1936 - July 27, 2021

Jack Koivisto, 84, of Crystal Falls, MI, died July 27, 2021, at the Oscar G. Johnson Veterans Medical Center in Iron Mountain, MI.

Jack was born in Dines, WY, to Jacob and Eleanor (Lindstrom) Koivisto on September 8, 1936. He served in the United States Navy for 25 years. He graduated from Southern Illinois University. He married Alice Johnson in Amasa, MI She preceded him in death. He worked as a director of Human Resources for Scot Forge in Chicago, IL. Jack married Rachael (Potter) McBride on July 14, 2004, in Crystal Falls.

Jack was a friendly face around the community. He was a member of the American Legion, the VFW, and the Masons. He was Michigan's Legionnaire of the Year in 2013. He was also an active member of the United Lutheran Church in Crystal Falls and served as their lay minister for many years.

Jack is preceded in death by his first wife, Alice, and his son, Matt.

He is survived by his wife, Rachael; his daughters, Karen (Gerry) Mitrenga, Sue (Mark) Findley, and Karla (Kevin) Rogers; and his son, Daniel (Gabriel) Koivisto.

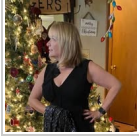
