James Richard Dunkel, of Florence, Wisconsin, was called to Heaven by his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Friday, April 17, 2026.

James was born on February 5, 1953, to the late Gustave and Lorraine (Nichols) Dunkel. He graduated from Florence High School in 1971 and went on to earn a degree in Psychology and Sociology from the University of Wisconsin–Green Bay in 1976.

In 1979, James returned to Florence and began his lifelong career as a social worker with the Florence County Human Services Department. He faithfully served his community in that role for 36 years before retiring in 2015.
