James A. Hulce, 65 of Crystal Falls, passed away on Wednesday, August 28, 2013 at Northstar Health System in Iron River. He was born on September 5, 1947 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Mamie (Koivu) Hulce. He attended the Crystal Falls Schools, and then enlisted in the United States Army, serving in Viet Nam from 1966 to 1968. After being honorably discharged from the U.S. Army, he worked as a laborer with the Construction and General Laborers Union-Local 1329 in both Michigan and Illinois. Jim most recently retired from the Maintenance Department at the Lac Vieux Desert Casino in Watersmeet. He was a member of the Tufts-Rondon Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2891, and an active member of the American Legion Post 87. He loved hunting and fishing, and especially spending time on his motorcycle. Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Kenneth Hulce.
