Jamie M. Janov

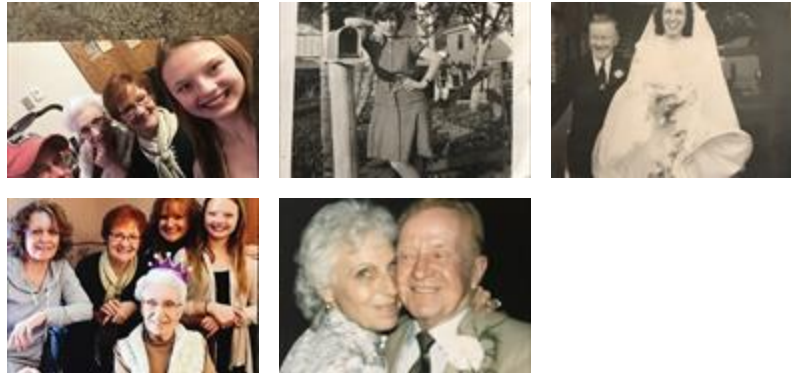
