Jean Stella Tuhowski, 93, of Crystal Falls passed away Wednesday, October 5, 2022, at her home.

Jean was born May 7, 1929, in Chicago, IL, the daughter of John and Anna (Trojnar) Chmiel. She graduated from St. Joseph High School, and on May 7, 1951 she married George Tuhowski, Jr. at Five Holy Martyrs Church in Chicago, IL. He preceded her in death in 2009.
