Joyce A. Dahl, 86, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Thursday, July 31st at the Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls. Joyce was born on October 14, 1927 at the family home on Stager Lake in Mastodon Twp.

She was the daughter of the late Wesley and Delma (Holmes) Story-McCue and has been a longtime resident of the Crystal Falls area. Joyce graduated from Alpha High School in 1947. She married Roy R. Dahl on August 20, 1947 at the Methodist Church in Alpha. Roy preceded her in death on February 18, 2010. Joyce was an active member of Christ United Methodist Church and the Deborah Circle of the church. She was also a communion server and Sunday school teacher at the church for 30 years.
