Mary A. Lahna, 65 of Crystal Falls, passed away on Sunday November 6, 2011 at Marquette General Hospital. She was born on November 1, 1946 in Crystal Falls, daughter of Joseph John and the late Evelyn Wave (Schindler) Smokevitch. She attended school in Crystal Falls, graduating from Crystal Falls High School. She went on to attend the Cradle Infant Nursing School in Evanston, Illinois.
