Maymie C. "Mim" Jacobson, 97, of Crystal Falls, passed away on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at the Iron County Medical Care Facility.

Mim was born May 24, 1919 in Crystal Falls, daughter of the late Henry and Mary (Waline) Salmi. She graduated from Crystal Falls High School in 1936 and was a lifelong resident of the area. She married Reino Jacobson on June 29, 1940 and he preceded her in death on August 21, 2012 after 72 years of marriage. Mim worked for over 20 years as a bookkeeper for the First National Bank in Crystal Falls retiring in 1981. She was a member of the United Lutheran Church in Crystal Falls and sang in the choir for 60 years. Mim was an avid Green Bay Packer and Forest Park sports fan. She enjoyed baking, reading, gardening and spending time with family.
