Milton A. Martin, 86 of Crystal Falls, passed away on Tuesday, August 15, 2017 at Aspirus Health System in Iron River. He was born on September 24, 1930 in Shaunavon, Saskatchewan, Canada, son of the late Awald and Bertha (Richter) Martin. He graduated from Shaunavon High School in 1948, and went on to receive his X-Ray and Lab Certification from Grey Nuns Hospital in Regina, Saskatchewan. He had dual citizenship in the United States and Canada. In 1956 he moved to Edgerton, Wisconsin where he was employed as a Lab and X-Ray Technician. In 1956 he was drafted in to the United States Army and was Honorably discharged in 1958. In 1959 he attended St. Luke's Hospital of Nursing in Racine, Wisconsin, graduating and passing his boards to become an RN in 1962. From 1963 to 1964 he attended the Minneapolis School of Anesthesia, and became a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist. He then worked as an anesthetist for 30 years until retiring in September of 1994.

Milton married Karen Moyle on February 20, 1965 at the Guardian Angels Church, and have spent more than 52 wonderful years together. He was a member of the Guardian Angel Catholic Church, Life member of the Knights of Columbus, and he was a Major in the Iron Mountain Civil Air Patrol where he served as Commander for 5 years. He enjoyed flying and held a private and instrument ratings. He had also worked on his commercial and multi

engine ratings.
