Olga V. Sartori, 95, of Crystal Falls, passed away peacefully on Thursday, Sept. 19, 2019 at Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls.

Olga was born August 30, 1924 in Crystal Falls, daughter of the late Battista and Mary (DeMuri) Girolimon.
