CRYSTAL FALLS - Pauline Helen Martin, 86, of Crystal Falls, died on Saturday, Aug. 8, 2009, at Marquette General Hospital in Marquette.

She was born on Feb. 19, 1923, in Crystal Falls, daughter of the late Joel and Anna (Korkela) Anderson. Pauline was a resident of Crystal Falls for most of her life. She graduated from Crystal Falls High School in 1941.

She married Robert Martin on May 30, 1942, in Crystal Falls. He preceded her in death on Feb. 17, 1992.

Pauline owned and operated Martin's Grocery Store along with her husband from 1958 until retiring in 1974. Visitation will be Friday from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. at the United Lutheran Church in Crystal Falls.

There will be a VFW Auxiliary Service held at 10:45 a.m. Friday.

The funeral service will follow at 11 a.m. at the church. Pastor Bonny Kinnunen will officiate.

Burial will be in the Evergreen Cemetery in Crystal Falls. Pauline's grandchildren will serve as pallbearers.
