Robert Earl Bugby, 95, of Iron River Michigan, died Sunday, September 19, 2021 in Woodruff, WI surrounded by his family.

Bob was born July 6, 1926 in Grayling, Michigan, son of the late Egbert and Bertha (Markwart) Bugby. Bob graduated from Grayling High School in 1944 and attended General Motors Institute. Bob was an US Army machine gunner in WWII that liberated Europe as part of the Golden Acorn division of the 87th Infantry. He married Carol Renshaw on August 22, 1953 in Flushing, MI. Bob retired from St. Joseph Hospital, Flint MI, in 1984 where he was the Director of Materials Management. Bob and Carol have been residents of Iron River since 1997 previously residing in Flushing and Cadillac.

Bob and Carol spent winters in Seminole Florida where he was very active in shuffleboard at Clearwater and Pinellas Parks. He lived for hunting, fishing, family and the great outdoors.

Bob is survived by his wife of 68 years, Carol; three children, Linda (the late Mark) Allen of Mukwonago, Wisconsin, Gerald (Connie) Bugby of Iron River, MI, and Dale (Kristi) Bugby of Bonita Springs, FL.; two grandchildren, Brent (Tiffany) Allen and Chad (Kiah) Allen; and four great grandchildren.
