



## Rocky Farrell

October 18, 1961 - October 18, 2010

Rocky A. Farrell, 49, of Crystal Falls, died on Monday, Oct. 18, 2010, as a result of a four-wheeler accident.

He was born March 21, 1961, in Iron Mountain, son of George and Darlene (Jones) Farrell. Rocky was a lifelong resident of the area and graduated from Forest Park High School in 1979. He attended Michigan Technological University in Houghton for several years before returning to Crystal Falls to work in the family logging business. Rocky was an avid bowler and loved the outdoors.

He is survived by his parents, George and Darlene Farrell of Crystal Falls; two daughters, India Schindler and Sierra Schindler, both of Iron River; two brothers, Todd (Joan) Farrell of Clovis, N.M. and Perry Farrell of Crystal Falls; his maternal grandmother, Katherine Jones of Crystal Falls; and many aunts, uncles, cousins, and family.
