



## Roger D. Sheltnrow

September 2, 1934 - February 24, 2019

Roger Dean Sheltnrow, age 84, of Crystal Falls, died Sunday, February 24, 2019 at Marquette General Hospital in Marquette, Michigan.

He was born September 2, 1934 in Crystal Falls Michigan, son of the late Archie and Elizabeth (Dunsmore) Sheltnrow. He graduated from Forest Park High School, class of 1952. He later attended radio school training while in the military. Roger served in the Army's 3rd Armored Division from 1957 to 1959 stationed stateside at Fort Polk Louisiana and for a short time in Frankfurt, Germany.

Roger married Isabel Lastimosa on August 10, 1973 and they resided in Crystal Falls. She preceded him in death on January 8, 2016. Roger worked as a letter carrier for the US Postal Service for many years retiring in 1995. Roger loved cutting wood and working around the family home. Roger was a very busy man in his retirement years, and was often commented on his firewood "wall" that surrounded his yard in the fall.

He is survived by one son, Rick Sheltnrow (Kristin) of Iron River, MI; one sister, Viola Kalinich of Chino Valley, Arizona. He was preceded in death by his wife, Isabel; one brother, Arthur Sheltnrow in 1991.
