Scott Vincent Camp, age 61, of Crystal Falls passed away unexpectedly on December 22nd, 2025, at his home.

Scott was a 1982 graduate of Forest Park High School. Scott began his career in Green Bay, Wisconsin, as a professional truck driver, which he took pride in for over 35 years. Scott retired from Bayland Transport before moving back to Crystal Falls in 2023. He was currently employed at Crystal Fresh Market.
