57 of Amasa, passed away on Saturday, September 29, 2012 at her home after a 3 year battle with Leukemia. She loved her time spent with family and friends at their Horse Camp at the Triangle Ranch in Amasa. Sharon is survived by her loving husband of more than 37 years, John Flowers of Amasa; her son Jake Flowers of Seward, Alaska; her brother, William Beebe of Las Vegas, NV.
