Waino H. Korkiamaki,

96, of Alpha, passed away on Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at Iron County Medical Care Facility in Crystal Falls. Waino was born on May 2, 1920 in Crystal Falls, the son of the late Victor and Hedda (Hudenpaa) Korkiamaki. Waino has been a lifelong resident of Crystal Falls. He joined the United States Army and served from 1941- 1943 in the European Theatre of Operations during WWII. His military service included becoming missing in action (MIA) and a prisoner of war (POW). He was awarded the purple heart. After returning from the war, Waino married Audrey Iverson. They raised their family on the family farm in Mansfield. Audrey preceded him in death in 2001. In his younger years Waino enjoyed hunting and fishing. He loved farming and later in his life kept a large garden. Most recently he has enjoyed playing checkers with his granddaughter Brandie.

In addition to his parents and wife, Waino was preceded in death by his grandson, Lance Warren; great grandson, Timothy "TJ" Warren; brothers, Isaac and Armas and sisters, Martha, Hilja, Saimi and Tyne.
